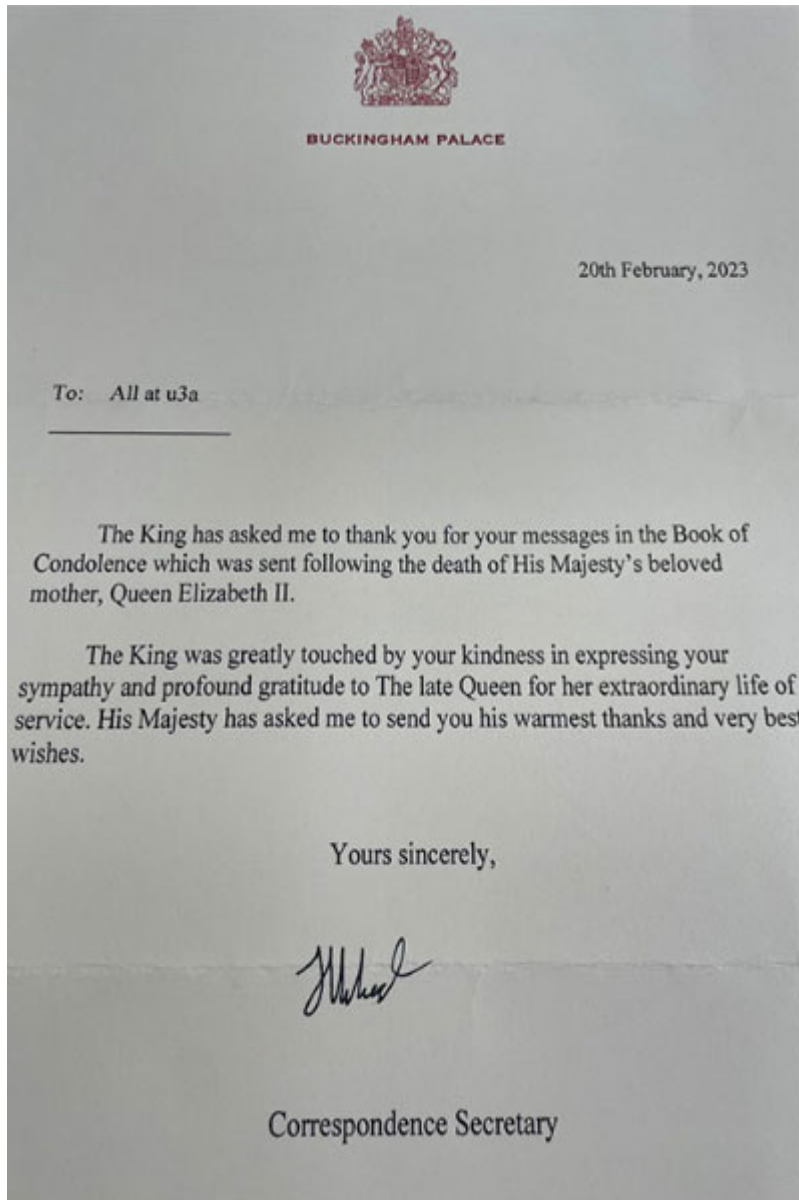


A Letter to u3a from the King
